Hope this finds you well. I am sorry that I am writing in English, but I do so for practical reasons. Indeed, I am writing regarding the event announced in the Poster here attached and in order to communicate the following:

1) If you/your Colleagues are interested, as I hope you/they might be, you (or Colleagues) are kindly invited to send me a Paper-Proposal for the Congress from 29-31 between now and May 15 as follows:

- a. Title and Sub-Title;
- b. Abstract (ca. 250 words)
- c. Bibliography.
- d. At the end of the document, please, add a short Biographical note.

2) I strongly advise that the Submissions are in English, since the papers presented in other languages might lack attendance. Yet, I do not exclude the use of the Italian Language either.

3) We are completely waiving Registration Fees for the conference from 29-31 of July. The participation in the WORLD CONGRESS (1-8 of August), however, requires the payment of a relatively high Registration Fee.

I certainly am not happy that this event does not take place at our University, but so are the facts of life. In any case, I think that the event at Villa Mirafiori is destined to be an excellent opportunity for interaction and dialogue with colleagues from all over the world even if in a scale much smaller than the XXV World Congress itself.
