
What method for a theology at the service of evangelisation?

Ten years ago, Prof. Lucas Francisco Mateo-Seco completed his journey. His academic and spiritual legacy proved especially fruitful. In particular, the passing of the years has highlighted the depth of his approach to theological method, capable of combining scientific rigour and service to the Church's evangelising task, fidelity to tradition and openness to contemporary demands, study of texts, especially the Church Fathers, and dogmatic synthesis.
